The **Mandate** of **Research Manitoba (formerly the Manitoba Health Research Council)** is to promote and support, and coordinate the funding of, research in the health, natural and social sciences, engineering and the humanities in Manitoba.

The **Research Advisory Committee (RAC)** provides strategic advice and makes recommendations to the Research Manitoba Board on research-related and peer review opportunities and activities. The membership of RAC should reflect the broad experience with research in the health, natural and social sciences, engineering and the humanities in Manitoba.

Research Manitoba is accepting nominations from all research disciplines. However, at this time, the priority will be to broaden the membership of RAC from the former Manitoba Health Research Council, which currently consists of members from the health research community.

Commitment: RAC meets approximately 4 to 6 times per year. Committee appointments are for a 3 year term.
