Opportunity:

Research Manitoba measures the impact of research in the province by assessing knowledge creation levels; the contribution of research to building capacity; the influence of research in decision and policy making, professional practice and other effects; and, the contribution to or development of health and socio-economic impacts. Research Manitoba is developing research impact narratives that illustrate the links between health/non-health and socio-economic impacts (such as changes in treatment, new/improved health and other products/services, start-ups, etc.) with the original research activities.

Reporting to the Manager, Evaluation and Impact, he/she will be responsible for:

- Gathering project and other relevant documents, statistics and other data relating to the research activities and the health/non-health and socio-economic impacts that are under study,
- Interviewing researchers and other persons that have been involved with the research activity and the impacts,
- Collating and analyzing collected data and information,
- Preparing tables and charts, and
- Writing narratives about research impacts.
- Assisting with the development of an evaluation plan for the Research Improvements through Harmonization in Manitoba initiative, gathering primary and secondary data, collating and analyzing collected data and information, and other tasks relating to the evaluation activity.

The Researcher, Evaluation and Impact is given a degree of independence within the job description. Interviewing researchers and others involved in the research activity and subsequent impact of the research, collating the collected data, preparing charts and tables and writing narratives are included in the task defined work.

Qualifications and Experience:

EDUCATION: A recent graduate or graduating student in an appropriate area (e.g. economics, business or public administration, social sciences, sciences, statistics) and/or a combination of

education, training, and progressively responsible experience.

EXPERIENCE: Experienced in interviewing/interacting with people, data analysis, report writing, and proficient in Excel. Familiarity with evaluation a plus.

ABILITIES: Problem solving, taking initiative, effective planning, organizing, and effective verbal and written communication skills.

The salary range for this position is \$23 to \$25 per hour, depending upon the qualifications and experience of the selected applicant plus a competitive benefits package. The full-time equivalent of this position is 35 hours, the successful candidate will be required to fulfill their work 7 hours/day, 5 days/week.
