

## REPORTING REQUIREMENTS FOR RESEARCH MANITOBA TRAINEE AWARDS

Trainee award recipients are to report the outputs and outcomes of their funded research project at the completion of their award. **Outputs** are defined as the tangible findings or the direct products or services of research activities. **Outcomes** are the changes, benefits, or other effects that happen as a result of the research. Outputs and Outcomes are collectively referred to as **Impact**. ***Please report only on outputs and outcomes supported by this Research Manitoba award.***

The report will be used in our ongoing efforts to communicate the value and benefits of research to our funders, our stakeholders, and the public. The progress and the impact of funding informs Research Manitoba's strategies and programs and is a vital component to justify and ensure long-term and sustainable funding. The reports are also important tools for Research Manitoba's accountability with the Provincial Government.
