To do so, we will fund operating research grants to projects that have potential for significant impact based on scientific excellence, and relevance to adult and/or geriatric mental health and the overall health and well-being of older adults.

This Program aims to support interdisciplinary research projects with the potential to enhance adult mental health, geriatric health and/or overall health and well-being of older adults within the Province of Manitoba.

The following priority areas have been identified for this research grant:

- Novel therapeutics;
- Remote access and artificial intelligence;
- Indigenous health;
- Improvements to quality of care;
- and/or Improvements to geriatric care.

Applicants must describe how their program of research fits with one or more of the above priority areas.
